

Past Year Reported Use - 12 to 17 Year Olds




Both rates showed declines, **but FL youth report higher** rates than youth nationwide.









What's the Difference?

The Florida Medical Examiner Commissioners Reports State:

Fentanyl:

Synthetic opioid analgesic supplied in transdermal patches and also available for oral, nasal, intravenous, and spinal administration.

Fentanyl is also produced illicitly and currently many fentanyl occurrences represent the ingestion of illicit fentanyl rather than pharmaceutically manufactured fentanyl.

Fentanyl Analog:

A synthetic opioid structurally similar to fentanyl. Many analogs of fentanyl are pharmacologically more potent than fentanyl.

Carfentanil is an analog of fentanyl approved for veterinary use only.

Why the Concern?

The CDC reported that 2020 showed the highest number of drug overdose deaths ever recorded - 93,000+.



In September 2021, the DEA issued a public safety alert about a sharp increase of fake prescription pills laced with fentanyl and methamphetamine.

Fentanyl is up to 100 times more potent than morphine. As little as 2 milligrams can be fatal.

In 2020, the FL Medical Examiner data showed 6,150 people died from overdoses caused by fentanyl and fentanyl analogs.


That equates to nearly 17 Floridans each day.

The Florida Department of Health reports, "Recent overdoses and deaths have occurred following use of illicit drugs, including marijuana, cocaine, and counterfeit prescriptions, as a result of these illicit substances containing fentanyl or similar extremely potent compounds."

Often, individuals are unaware the drug they have overdosed from has been laced with fentanyl.

Historical Overview of Fentanyl Occurrences¹


(Present and Cause) 2006 to 2020

Fentanyl Occurrences In Deceased Persons (Present and Cause)







In 2020, 94.7% of fentanyl deaths in Florida were accidental.

In 2020, 73.6% of all drug-caused deaths in Florida were related to fentanyl.
